

# Free Alphabet

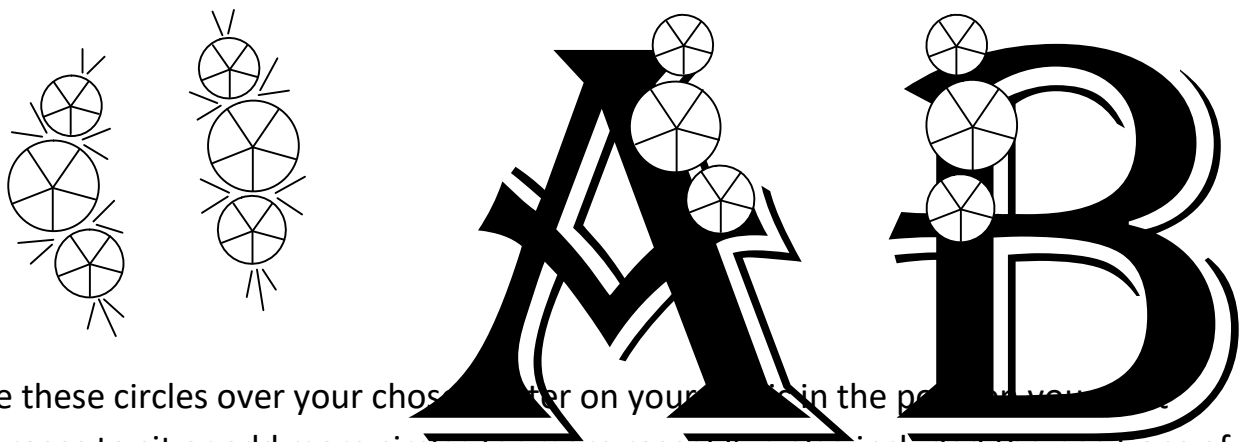
## ALGERIAN FONT



Print off the page(s) with your chosen letters/numbers and trace them onto your embroidery fabric with a pencil, waterproof pen or erasable transfer pen or use the prick and pounce method.

If you want to paint your letters with fabric paint or colour them in with coloured pencils then do this next (see the video, details below). If using fabric paint, let it dry and fix by ironing with a hot iron following the instructions on your brand of fabric paint. Place a backing fabric behind your embroidery fabric to give you a more stable ground to work on and frame both pieces together in your chosen embroidery frame.

### Rose motif templates



Trace these circles over your chosen letter on your fabric in the position you want your roses to sit or add more circles for more roses! I've also included the positions of the leaves and the spokes for weaving around which you can draw on also if you like or do freehand when you stitch.

***Tip: they look good on the widest section of each letter!***
